Highlights of this year

Sustainable production of vegetables

Groups of women have joined forces to work on planting vegetables in high-tunnels. These structures provide a safer environment to prevents pests that can affect the crops. Women have also been involved in the production of organic fertilizer and seed. The future plan is to produce enough varieties and quantities of vegetables to sell in a local farmer's market.





Diversified food sources

Farmers like Wilson have learned to diversify their farms to grow corn, green peppers, plantains, and cassava. All these products serve to provide a better diet to the farmers' families and to increase their income. "Before the program, I had difficulty accessing vegetable seeds, and because I did not have the money to hire workers, I would rarely grow vegetables in my plot," said Wilson.

Conservation agriculture

This year farmers began experimenting with conservation agriculture (CA) on their plots. As part of the training, farmers were asked to grow corn in one plot, with some of the corn being grown the traditional way and the rest being grown using conservation practices. Farmers were surprised to see how the CA crops were able to withstand drought and give a better harvest.



Mobilizing young people

Together with our partner AJS, World Renew and CRWM are supporting impact clubs for at-risk youth. This program is not only teaching young people values and vocational skills; it is motivating young people to raise their voices in advocacy activities in their communities. During this year, young people from four communities in Tegucigalpa were able to hold marches for peace, campaigns against domestic violence, campaigns for the protection of animals, and a reforestation campaign called "Adopt a tree."
