

## March 2017 Activity Report

### Canada

#### **Alberta**

World Renew regional managers are working with Mennonite Disaster Services to set up a reconstruction site in response to the Ft McMurray fire. The plan is for reconstruction to begin early May.



### United States

#### **California**

World Renew has a reconstruction site in Angels Camp (Calaveras County) in response to wildfires in 2015. Back to back teams of volunteers continue to rebuild homes.

#### **Florida**

World Renew continues to send volunteers to its reconstruction site in Century. This is in response to a 2016 tornado.

#### **Louisiana**

After a record setting unmet needs assessment, World Renew regional managers continue to work with the recovery organization in Livingston Parish to see if there are other ways to assist with their recovery. There will be 2 one-week groups working in Louisiana this month.



#### **Michigan**

World Renew staff continues to work with the long term recovery group in the Detroit area in response to the July 2014 flooding. There will be a one-week group working in Detroit this month.

#### **Mississippi**

World Renew has a 1-week group working in Clarksdale this month.

### **New Jersey**

World Renew has 4 one-week groups in the Highland Park area. They are repairing homes damaged by Hurricane Sandy in 2012.

### **North Carolina**

World Renew regional managers are in contact with recovery organizations to possibly set up a long term reconstruction site in response to Hurricane Matthew of October 2016. World Renew has a 1-week group in working in Tarboro.



### **Saipan**

World Renew continues to send volunteers to Saipan. This is in response to a 2015 typhoon.

### **South Carolina**

World Renew regional managers continue to connect with long term recovery groups in South Carolina in response to the flooding in 2015. A short term reconstruction site has been set up and we will be sending volunteers there until mid-April. Four 1-week groups are working in Manning.

### **Texas**

World Renew is sending volunteers to its reconstruction sites in San Marcos and the Rio Grande Valley. These are both in response to flooding in 2015.

### **West Virginia**

Orland Park CRC is building a home over the course of 4 weeks in Greenbrier County. There are 4 one-week groups working in West Virginia in March.
