## **EXAMPLE**

## Strengthen your facility

- Check all roofing for loose singles, areas that need repairs
- Check trees around facility possibly needing removal/trimming because of weak areas.

## Who is responsible?

John Smith, along with Buildings & Grounds will examine the roof and trees. They will be responsible for scheduling of repairs/tree removal.

Threat: VOLCANOES

Who is responsible?



Communication system to announce safest route for evacuation.
Shelter-in-Place – clearly marked, handicapped accessible, capacity indicated
What supplies are necessary in the shelter and who is responsible for them.
What is the process for assisting those with access or functional needs and who is responsible.

What communication system will be used between the shelters and those directing people where to go?
