A summary of activities this month.

Alabama

 Tornado, March 2019: Connecting and meeting with leadership in Lee County to offer services.

Alaska

• Earthquake, 2018: Working with recovery leaders who may be requesting services.

California

 Fires, 2018: Continuing to connect with recovery leaders about services that would be helpful; there are many variables and decisions to be made by all parties in the aftermath of wildfires.

Florida

- Hurricane Irma, 2017: The facilitated site in LaBelle closes this month after 13 consecutive weeks of hosting volunteer groups to repair homes. Two one-week groups from Washington and Michigan are serving at this site this month. There is a one-week group from Michigan serving in Volusia this month.
- Hurricane Michael, 2018: A needs assessment is taking place in Gulf County; we are working with several other counties who are interested in needs assessments.

Georgia

• Hurricane Michael, 2018: Working with several communities who continue to recover and request needs assessments.

lowa

• Flooding, March 2019: Connecting with local leadership about recovery and how, when, and where to help.



Louisiana

• Flood, 2016: The reconstruction site in Hammond closes this month. This site has been open since January 2018. Fourteen 3-week teams have worked in Hammond repairing homes.

Michigan

• Flood, March 2019: 45 volunteers helped muck-out flooded homes in Newaygo this month.

Mississippi

• Tornado, 2017: There is a one-week group from Michigan repairing homes in Hattiesburg this month.

Missouri

• Flooding, March 2019: Connecting with local leadership about recovery and how, when, and where to help.

Nebraska

• Flood, March 2019: Connecting and meeting with flood response leaders in Nebraska identifying when and where to help with clean-up.

North Carolina

- Hurricane Matthew, 2016: The reconstruction site in Tarboro closes this month for the summer. There are two one-week groups repairing homes in Swan Quarter and Fayetteville.
- Hurricane Florence, 2018: Meeting with recovery leaders and pursuing several possible communities for long-term reconstruction. There are two one-week groups repairing homes in New Port and building estimators are in Pamlico County this month.

Puerto Rico

• Hurricane Maria, 2017: Home repairs will wind down as summer approaches but there is much work to be done and will resume in the fall.

Saipan

• Typhoon, 2018: Working on the details of sending a building estimator to the island this spring.

South Dakota

• Flood, 2019: Monitoring the aftermath of flooding on the east and west sides of the state.

Texas

• Hurricane Harvey, 2017: Requests for needs assessments continue to come in. The reconstruction site in Dickinson closes for the summer and will reopen in the fall. There is a one-week group from New York repairing homes in Beaumont this month.

Washington

• Wildfire, 2014: A one-week group from Washington is working in Okanogan this month.

West Virginia

• Flood, 2016: Four one-week groups from Michigan are repairing homes in several counties this month.
