Pray for World Renew Around the World

Violence from the militant group Boko Haram in Nigeria has created loss, pain, and suffering for many families. High levels of malnutrition and food insecurity are among the major concerns for vulnerable families affected by the violence. World Renew and partners will provide funds and goats to 750 of the most vulnerable families in Maiduguri. Please pray for peace and plenty in Nigeria.

- <u>San Marcos. Texas</u>: closed permanently in April. Thank you to everyone for all your work here!
- Rio Grande Valley, Texas: closed for the summer but will open for a brief period in the fall to finish projects.
- Hammond, Louisiana: closed for summer, reopening in the fall.
- <u>Tarboro</u>, <u>North Carolina</u>: closed for summer, reopening in the fall.
- Puerto Rico: We continue to work with our partners to establish a plan for how we can help the rebuilding efforts. We hope to schedule future teams and dates later in the summer. Continue to watch the Opportunity Link for postings or call Diana in the office if you have questions.
