



Thank you for giving the gift of a calf

When a family lives on only what they can grow, we call it *subsisting* and it is not really the same thing as living: it's not an *abundant* life of enough resources and resilience and possibility.

World Renew wants transformation for our brothers and sisters around the world, people like Yun and Neum. They live in rural Cambodia where many people *subsist*, growing what they eat with no income for things like medicine or school fees. With a local partner there, World Renew supports a cow project in Yun and Neum's village, and they received a calf. The *abundance* of a few calves starts to show when they reproduce: the owners pay back their loan to their group, and another family receives a cow.

This is just what Yun and Neum did. Subsequent calves stayed with them and have enabled them to sell milk for extra income, which they use to send their oldest daughter to school in the capital city and pay school fees for their other children at the local school. Instead of *subsisting*, Yun and Neum are experiencing better nutrition, a more secure income, and the possibility that education promises their children. **That's a transformation!**

Your gift of a calf can make change like this happen for a family in India, where World Renew is responding to an emerging enthusiasm for dairy cows as a livelihood. **Your gift is an opportunity for another family to experience a more abundant life.**
