

Case Narrative Form – List of Questions

The following is the list of questions that make up the Case Narrative Form. For a fillable version of the form, please contact a World Renew Refugee Program staff member.

- **1.** Please list the names and dates of birth of all family members included in this application.
- 2. Please describe in as much detail as possible the specific events that led you to flee your home country. You should include any actions taken against you, your family members, or any others in a similar situation.

For each incident, specify the date (month/year) the event(s) occurred.

If the events were generalized, please describe how they affected you personally or what led to you fearing for your safety.

Please indicate whether you sought protection from the authorities of your country and if not, why not.

- **3.** Please describe in chronological order when exactly you and your family members left your home and what route you took.
- **4.** Explain the mode of transportation you took, the types of vehicles or airlines used, flight numbers, the date of travel, how you paid for travel, etc.
- 5. If you and your family did not leave together, please explain the route each family member took and the reason(s) why you did not travel together.
- **6.** Please indicate whether someone planned your travel or helped you leave or enter a country and how much you paid.
- 7. Are you able to return to your home country? If not, why?
- 8. Since arriving in your current country of residence, have you returned to your country of origin, even briefly? If yes, how many times and under what circumstances?
- **9.** Do you maintain a property, a business, or are you currently employed in your country of origin?
- **10.** In the country where you are living now, do you have the right to work, go to school, or move freely? Are you able to avail yourself of these rights?
- **11.** Are you residing in a refugee camp or in an urban area? Please explain.
- **12.** Since arriving in the country where you currently live, how have you supported yourself and (if applicable) your family?
