World Renew Disaster Response Services (DRS) requests your prayers and financial support to respond to a massive flood in Louisiana, called the worst in the U.S. since Super-Storm Sandy. Heavy rain started on August 12, 2016, flooding Baton Rouge and Denham Springs, and killing eleven people. More than 40,000 homes were damaged or destroyed, and 10,000 people needed emergency shelter. Many lost everything they own.

“World Renew DRS has already been working with communities after flooding in Louisiana earlier this year,” said Len and Carrie Blauwkamp, DRS regional managers. “Some of the same communities were flooded again in August. It’s devastating. We are expanding our work to include the recent damage.”

World Renew DRS is responding to Louisiana floods as follows:

- DRS volunteers arrived in Baton Rouge the week of August 22.
- DRS is planning recovery efforts, once the water recedes, with community leaders.
- DRS will make plans for assisting homeowners with tasks such as property clean up, mucking out homes, and making essential repairs.
- DRS volunteer managers and staff make connections with other agencies to plan long-term recovery, including home reconstruction.

Here’s how you can help.
