In northeastern Bangladesh, Akhil Biswas was struggling. He had invested all he had in a duck farm, but when the ducks started dying, he didn't know why and he had no one to ask. Akhil's wife had to find work, his son dropped out of school, and Akhil wrestled with despair.

For rural Bangladeshis like Akhil, life is often about subsistence. One setback can upend a family. Failure is not a “learning opportunity.” It's devastation. World Renew works in communities of poverty and subsistence to help God's people there find resources and experience resilience and success. We want them to live an abundant life with more awareness of God's love for them.

Akhil met someone from a local partner in Bangladesh who told him about World Renew's agriculture programs and the opportunity to get training he lacked. Akhil joined readily and learned how to care for ducks, how to diagnose disease, and vaccinate a flock. He built connections with the local government's livestock office and received a loan to invest in buying more ducks, this time armed with knowledge that could help him succeed.

Akhil has since paid back his loan, reinvested his profits, and is a successful farmer of 600 ducks!
