## Thank you for helping a refugee

**Our world has never recorded a greater number of people driven from their homelands than is happening today**. The numbers are numbing: 11 million from Syria, 4 million from South Sudan, 4 million from the Democratic Republic of Congo, over a million Rohingya from Myanmar. In all, more than 68 million people worldwide are displaced — each one an individual who has lost possessions, home, security, land, even family. Our heart aches with yours over this human suffering.

From monthly food assistance and winter clothes in Syria to latrines and communal kitchens in Bangladesh, we work to meet the essential needs of refugees and remind them that they are not forgotten.

**Uganda is host to Bidibidi,** one of the largest refugee camps in the world, sheltering nearly 300,000 refugees who have fled the violence of civil war in South Sudan. **Beste Gire**, whose three sons died in the war, arrived there with her two daughters and nothing else. Beste has the will to live and to make the most of life where she is. Gifts like yours help provide her and her family with a safe latrine, so that a lack of sanitation will not be a stumbling block as she seeks some semblance of normal, peaceful life.

In **South Sudan**, **Sunday** was struggling to feed her family. Internally displaced within her country, she tried to survive by collecting and selling firewood, a dangerous job for a woman to do alone. Food supplies she received from World Renew is providing her and her children with two meals a day.

Fourteen-year-old **Asima** is a Rohingya refugee living with her mother in a refugee camp of nearly a million people in **Bangladesh**. Myanmar security forces, on a campaign of "ethnic cleansing," killed her father, brother, and sister. Asima finds some comfort in communal kitchens and portable stoves built by World Renew, that allow women and children to cook in a secure environment without having to risk their safety. **Your gift will meet a refugee's essential needs and remind them that someone cares about their suffering**.
