Caring for children, earning income, making their way often without education or skills and often without support – women around the world face significant burdens every day. Disaster amplifies these challenges and leaves women and girls at even greater risk.

World Renew is committed to caring for people who are vulnerable, people that Jesus identified as "the least of these." Your gift of helping women and girls in disaster supports many efforts, from meeting emergent needs for food to supporting sustainable income generation for women and the families they head.

In **South Sudan**, where thousands are internally displaced by violent unrest, Sunday Mario struggles to feed her two young sons by collecting and selling firewood. Emergency food aid from World Renew has provided food for her children to eat twice a day.

In **Uganda**, Regina kept her family fed by farming — until drought killed all her crops and the family suddenly found themselves missing meals, day after day. Emergency food assistance and seeds for planting next year's crop from

World Renew are giving Regina hope that she and her family will be healthy and working productively on their own land again soon.

In **Bangladesh**, Asima is a 14-year-old Rohingya refugee whose father, brother, and sister were killed by Myanmar's security forces intent on "ethnic cleansing." Now living with her mother in a refugee camp, Asima finds some comfort in communal kitchens and with the portable stoves built by World Renew that allow women and children to cook in a secure environment without having to risk their safety collecting firewood.

In the **Philippines**, Suzeth lost her livestock in a typhoon and, as a widow with children, wondered how she would take care of her family. A World Renew livelihood rehabilitation project helped Suzeth with a small business loan to start a convenience store and become a small business owner.
