In northeastern Bangladesh, average annual rainfall can reach 4000 mm (157 in). This is paradise for a duck. World Renew takes advantage of this in the fight against rampant malnutrition there through use of an amazing animal: the Khaki Campbell, a duck capable of laying over 300 eggs a year — a strong and steady source of nutrition. We call them Superducks and, when you give a flock, you are giving TEN of them — enough to transform many lives in many ways. Here's an example of the exponential gift of a flock:

Manjura lives in northeastern Bangladesh, where 59% of children experience stunting due to malnutrition. Abandoned by her husband, Manjura struggled to feed herself, her aging mother, and her granddaughter. Then she qualified to receive two Khaki Campbell ducks from World Renew. Manjura treasures them and has carefully grown her flock. She can see first-hand the connection between a duck egg's high-quality protein and growth for her granddaughter, between an egg's vitamins and minerals and robust health for her and her mother. As she has grown her flock, she enjoys not just eggs, but duck meat, extra income from selling eggs and feathers, even duck droppings as fertilizer to enhance her garden. No longer struggling to meet each day's needs, Manjura has a steady source of nutrition and income that supports her and her family.
