Bidibidi, in northwest Uganda, is one of the larger refugee camps in the world. Covering an area the size of Orlando, Florida, or Burlington, Ontario, it is home to 287,000 refugees who have fled South Sudan over the past five years to escape the violence of civil war.

For people who have watched family members killed before their eyes, it is a cruel irony that they must continue to watch loved ones and neighbors die in their chosen refuge for **simple lack of sanitation**. Without proper latrines or handwashing stations, cholera, typhoid, and dysentery run rampant, further traumatizing people who are already suffering.

Your gift of emergency hygiene and sanitation is helping families stay healthy so that they can focus on the other pressing demands in their lives.

People like Beste Gire — who arrived in Bidibidi with her two daughters and nothing else after the deaths of her three sons in South Sudan — want to reclaim a semblance of life. **Beste has the will to live and to make the most of life where she is.** Your gift allows women like Beste and her daughters to have reliable sanitation rather than the stumbling block of struggling without it.

World Renew, through local partners, is helping some of the most vulnerable people living in Bidibidi — people with disabilities, the elderly, orphans, and female-headed households. Together, more than 1,550 latrines have been built already. Your gift will help provide many people with more safety and better health on their way to a more hopeful future.

In the face of disaster, survivors still want to continue on. **They want to pursue life.**
