FACTS ON POVERTY


THE IMPORTANCE OF PARTNERSHIP & A HOLISTIC APPROACH

As 2021 came to a close, the UN projected that the COVID-19 pandemic had pushed another 143-163 million people around the world into poverty. 2020 was the first year since 1997 when the total number of people in poverty globally increased. Sadly, current calculations project that by 2030, an additional 50 million people will still be in poverty compared with pre-pandemic projections.

In our estimation, that outcome is unacceptable. And, through gifts from generous-hearted people like you, it is avoidable. However, the issue of poverty is multifaceted and often complex, intensified by a number of concerning trends brought on by COVID-19: an increase in the number of people experiencing hunger, outbreaks in conflict due to limited resources, elevated unemployment levels, inability of farmers to sell their crops at market, an increase in gender-based and domestic violence, continued spread of COVID-19 and other diseases due to scarce water and inadequate hygiene.

Together, these factors create a cycle of harm that threatens to bind communities in poverty for generations.

But that doesn't have to be the story. Thanks to World Renew's model, our staff and partners on the ground work with local churches and communities to help them identify existing strengths and access the support they need to create stable sources of food, clean water, and income. We also work with these communities to adapt to threats like climate change, natural disasters, and violence so they can weather setbacks like COVID-19 with greater ease.



Through locally sourced and community based development, donations like yours touch over a million lives each year. But we think the impact of each gift is best described story by story.

One of those stories includes Cecelia Naveia: a young woman whose life changed for good in 2021 through World Renew. Cecelia lives in Milange, Mozambique, where she raises vegetables to feed her family. After joining a World Renew savings group in her village, Cecelia's community loaned her the funds to buy two additional fields where she could plant corn and soybeans: leading to more stable income and food for her family. Through that investment, Cecelia not only paid back her loan within a year, but she also earned \$190 in profit, an extra income of six months, from her work. This income opens up pathways to better housing, education for her children, and future investments in clean water to keep her family healthy and her crops thriving.

Your choice to walk alongside World Renew helps people like Cecila to recognize themselves as image bearers of God and to live into the plans God has for them to glorify him. Let's glorify God together by ensuring all his children can access pathways out of poverty.

ACTION PLAN FOR CHURCHES GATHERING PHYSICALLY

Thank you for stepping up to organize your congregation's offering and partner in the work of World Renew. If your church is in a season of gathering physically, these are the steps you can take to ensure a smooth roll-out and execution.

TIME FRAME	ACTION
One week before World Renew Sunday	 Make a verbal announcement in church that the following Sunday you plan to engage the topic of poverty as a community and will be collecting a special offering to support the work of World Renew. Use bulletin announcement #1 (provided in this Planning Guide) If your church uses bulletin inserts, make sure to download and print off plenty of World Renew inserts for next week's service.
World Renew Sunday	 Hold an offering for World Renew during your collection. Make sure to download the World Renew video online to play during the offering and to select a few World Renew impact slides to play during Sunday morning pre-roll and postlude as bookends to your worship service. Use bulletin announcement #2
One week later	 Forward last week's collection to World Renew (by check or online) Use bulletin announcement #3 to celebrate the results of partnering with World Renew with your congregation and consider a verbal thank you to your congregation during announcement time

ATHERING PHYSICALLY

CREATIVE CAMPAIGN IDEAS FOR PHYSICAL GATHERINGS

Engaging your congregation on the topic of poverty can be as simple as a few announcements.

But, if you want to **make more of the week leading up to World Renew Sunday**, try some of these ideas for both the young and young-at-heart.

ENCOURAGE ENGAGEMENT

A visual display in a high-traffic area always catches people's attention. Consider involving your congregation in imagining the pathways of hope that God desires for all of us. Set aside a wall in your sanctuary or fellowship area with a large ream of butcher or craft paper that says "Pathways to Hope." Make sure to have colorful pens/markers nearby for people to use. Then, during your first World Renew Sunday announcement, encourage members young and old to visit the wall and add a phrase that is personal to them and represents a longing they have for the world. People can fill the blank in with whatever connects with them: "healing," "clean water," "justice," "love," "safety for girls," etc. If you have a bay of windows in your space, you can do the same thing with window markers. Watch the messages build over the next two Sundays and celebrate the phrases on World Renew Sunday. (Tip: this activity can inspire some great content for a Sunday morning sermon and worship set).

ACTION PLAN FOR ORGANIZERS WHO ARE GATHERING DIGITALLY

Thank you for stepping up to organize a World Renew Sunday for your congregation. You've got this. And we've got you. If you are one of many churches currently gathering in a digital space, or operating at reduced capacity for the safety of your congregation, this is a digital rollout designed to help you have a successful World Renew Sunday.

Just follow the schedule below for a smooth roll-out and execution.

TIME FRAME	ACTION
One week before offering	• Make a social announcement on your digital channels (Facebook, Instagram, Twitter and also Email) that the following Sunday you plan to engage the topic of poverty as a community and will be collecting a special offering to partner in the work of World Renew. Feel free to point people to pathwaysoutofpoverty.com or pathwaysoutofpoverty.ca to learn more. Use digital announcement #1 as your inspiration.
World Renew Sunday	 Take a collection for World Renew during your livestream. You can collect funds through your regular digital giving option or invite people to give directly to World Renew at pathwaysoutofpoverty.com or pathwaysoutofpoverty.ca. Don't forget to download and incorporate the World Renew video into your livestream. You are also free to post it to your website and social media separately for people to view. Publish digital announcement #2
One week later	 Use digital announcement #3 to thank your congregation and don't forget to verbally thank them as well during the service livestream.

ENCOURAGE ENGAGEMENT

The Sunday before World Renew Sunday, invite members from your congregation to share what "pathways to hope" means to them by writing on a piece of paper "A Pathway to ______." People can fill the blank in with whatever connects with them: "healing," "clean water," "justice," "love," "safety for girls," etc. If members of the congregation choose, they can then snap a picture holding their sign and email it to the email address you provide. Partner with your tech team to share a different image each week on your Facebook page or create a slide-show set to music to highlight your congregation to talk about the experience together. THERING DIGITALLY

CREATIVE CAMPAIGN IDEAS FOR DIGITAL GATHERINGS



When you shift the design of the banner images on social media and your church's website, it makes an impression on your community: insighting curiosity, signaling significance, and creating buzz. MARK THE MOMENT

Host a digital coffee hour on your church's preferred video conferencing platform to discuss global poverty and what is stirring in the hearts and minds of your congregation.
